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Banff National Park – Activity Six: *A Unique Look at Animals of Banff National Park (Introductory Activity)*

CLB: 3-7

Topic: Animals

Goal: Ask and answer questions

Language Focus: Writing

Material: Unique pictures of animals of Banff National Park

Groupings: Pairs or individuals

Activity Outline: Each Pair has a unique picture of an animal and a blank sheet. Each Pair must write down a question about their picture. The picture and question sheet is passed clockwise. Each Pair looks at the new picture and answers the question on the sheet. They write a new question and pass the picture and question sheet. Continue until you receive your original picture back. Answer the question. Looking at all the questions and answers, tell the story to the group about your picture.

*adaption: write a story about the picture with partner –first sentence is given (CLB 4-7); whole class writing or question starters given (CLB 3)
