Plan Your Park Adventure in Banff National Park

Wildlife and You

One of the most exciting things about visiting Banff National Park is the chance to view wildlife like bears and elk in their natural environment. Participants in this program will identify and learn about some of these animals, and what they can do to keep both themselves and wildlife safe.

Length: 90 minutes (presentation 30 minutes, Q&As 30 minutes) CLB Levels: 3-4



Life Lines – Exploring Banff's Wildlife Corridors and Crossings

This program introduces students to some of the animals that call Banff National Park home along with some of the challenges they face. Students will learn about how technology and careful management are helping wildlife move safely through the park, as well as actions they can personally take to support park wildlife.

Length: 60 minutes (presentation 30 minutes, Q&As 30 minutes) CLB Levels: 6-8
